

# Focus Awards Level 3 Award in Assessing Competence in the Work Environment (RQF)

## Overview

The Level 3 Award in Assessing Competence in the Work Environment, provides an entry point to understanding vocational assessment. Most training centres would expect that you have this qualification at the very least before you start assessing in the FE and HE sectors. You are not required to have any prior qualification or experience to start this course, just a passion to teach or train. This course will assist you regardless of your subject expertise, whether you teach music or coach people.

## Duration and Delivery

This course is designed to be completed online at the pace that suits you the best. It can take as little as 4 days or up to 3 weeks. The qualification is delivered through our Virtual Learning Environment.

## Assessment & Verification

All units within this course are internally analysed by our internal assessors and externally verified by the awarding organisation. The assessment takes the form of written assignments and demonstration of assessment skills through video recording, detailed guidance for which will be provided by the tutor.

## Eligibility Criteria

Learners should meet the following requirements:

- You should be aged 19 or over to undertake the qualification.
- Have access to atleast two learners on accredited courses.
